



Texas Industry Partnership

Overview

The Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) has allocated \$1 million to address skills gaps and ensure a talent pipeline is available to address regional industry needs through the Texas Industry Partnership (TIP) program. Private employers or corporate foundations can collaborate with a Local Workforce Development Board to apply for funding for Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) activities that support workforce development within six designated industry clusters. Boards may receive up to \$150,000 annually to match equal industry partner funding for job training activities.

Matching funds must support allowable WIOA activities and focus on six designated industry clusters:



- Advanced Technologies and Manufacturing
- Aerospace and Defense
- Biotechnology and Life Sciences
- Information technology
- Petroleum Refining and Chemical Products
- Energy

Allowable WIOA job training activities include:

- Training
- Mentoring
- Support services
- Skills assessments
- Cluster analysis
